The Landing at St. Robert's Center in Venice Beach is a no-cost, one-of-a-kind, daytime wellness & respite drop-in center for pregnant & parenting youth ages 14-24 and their children. We provide a safe, trauma-informed, home-like environment supporting positive parent/child attachments, purposeful parenting skills, healthy living and lifestyle choices, featuring:

Life's Basic Essentials — showers, meals and groceries, daytime resting rooms for parents and children, clothing, hygiene supplies/toiletries, laundry, support and guidance

Counseling & Therapy — individual and family, parenting groups & classes, children's play therapy

Baby & Children's Necessities — clothing, diapers, formula, supplies, and equipment

Workspace — computers, internet and WiFi service

Peace — a safe and peaceful space for nurturing, growth, healing and reflection. Yoga and meditation offered and encouraged.
